AVID Region 8 will once again offer a calendar of workshops and trainings designed to provide AVID coordinators, elective teachers, content teachers, counselors, and administrators with technical assistance and coaching in the areas of AVID data collection, certification, online resources, and articulated instruction and research-based strategies that support the school's efforts in closing the achievement gap and providing school-wide college-readiness for all students in grades 6-12. It remains vital that our site teams continue to attend and participate in our professional development series to maintain and enhance credible AVID programs that make a difference.

Number	Workshop	Description
1	Lesson Planning	Half-Day session providing teachers with sample lesson plans/strategies for the AVID elective class
1	Administrators' Workshop	Morning session providing AVID administrators with current vital information at the start of the school year.
1	Tutorology	Full-day session providing teachers with the training necessary to lead tutorials and train college and student tutors
2	School-wide Workshop	Full-day session providing teachers with the opportunity to visit AVID elective classes and take part in breakout sessions
3	Write Path Training	One full-day session in each county area during the year, for a total of 3 for the entire year for all of Region 8, providing attendees with a choice of content strands focusing on curriculum texts, materials, and strategies for the classroom
1	On-site WICR Training	Sessions of various lengths providing entire school staff with materials/strategies on specific WICR components

The cost for the AVID Workshop Series is the same as 2009-2010 for early registrants: **\$500.00 per school site by August 1, 2010**—unlimited attendees, including Write Path training and WICR Training for individual sites depending on availability and schedules permitting. **Late registration after August 1, 2010 will be \$650 per school site.**
